

W.N.C.P. Grade 12 Pre-Calculus Math Formula Sheet

Pythagorean Theorem

 $a^2 + b^2 = c^2$, where c is the length of the hypotenuse

Linear Relations

Slope:
$$m = \frac{y_{2} - y_{1}}{x_{2} - x_{1}}$$

Quadratic Formula

$$x = \frac{-b \pm \sqrt{b^2 - 4ac}}{2a}$$

Trigonometry

$$\sin \theta = \frac{opposite}{hypotenuse}$$

$$\cos \theta = \frac{adjacent}{hypotenuse}$$

$$\tan \theta = \frac{opposite}{adjacent}$$

$$\csc\theta = \frac{hypotenuse}{opposite}$$

$$\sec\theta = \frac{hypotenuse}{adjacent}$$

$$\cot\theta = \frac{adjacent}{opposite}$$

 Sine Law

 posite

$$\frac{\sin A}{a} = \frac{\sin B}{b} = \frac{\sin C}{c}$$

 ljacent
 $\frac{\cos A}{a} = \frac{\sin B}{b} = \frac{\sin C}{c}$

 cosine Law

 $a^2 = b^2 + c^2 - 2bc\cos(A)$



Area and Volume: for ALL calculations using π , <u>always use</u> $\pi = 3.14$

Area of a **circle** with radius
$$r$$
:
$$A = \pi r^2$$

Circumference of a **circle** with radius *r*

$$c = 2\pi r$$

Area of a **triangle** with base *b* and height *h*:

$$A = \frac{1}{2}bh$$

Volume of **Prism**:

V = area of base x height of the prism

Volume of **Pyramid**:

$$V = \frac{1}{3} \times \text{(the volume of the enclosing prism)}$$

Volume of **Cylinder** with height *h* and radius *r*:

$$V=\pi r^2 h$$

Volume of **Sphere** with radius *r*:

$$V = \frac{4}{3}\pi r^3$$

Combinations and Permutations:

$$_{n}P_{r} = \frac{n!}{(n-r)!}$$
 and $_{n}C_{r} = \frac{n!}{(n-r)!r!}$
